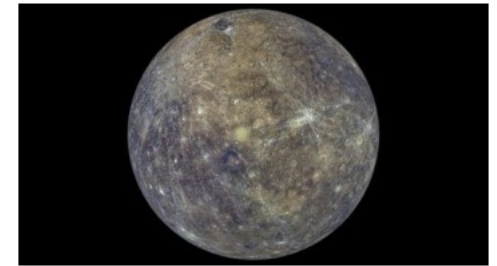
MARS

It has almost no atmosphere. It is extremely cold.

It is around 220 million kilometers from Earth. It takes almost a year to go there in a space rocket.
