CHECKLIST "A LIFE STORY"

1. You have contacted an elder from an English speaking country for your interview or if that is not the case, you have contacted an elder, close to you, with a fascinating story to tell.		
2. You have prepared your questions in advance following the pattern for interviews.		
3. Your questions are relevant: Your questions have obtained interesting information about the life, job, relationships, society, technology, etc of your elders.		
4. You have asked your interviewee about old sayings.		
5. The interview you have conducted have taught you about the evolution of society, how technology has evolved, old sayings and what they mean nowadays or any other interesting fact that elders communicate.		
6. Your interviewee has expressed freely about the topics and you have taken good note of their answers.		
7. You have reported all their answers using reported speech for statements and questions.
